## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SLOAN, IOWA BY AMENDING CHAPTER 21, SECTION 21.03 PERTAINING TO QUALIFICATIONS OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES

**21.03 QUALIFICATIONS OF TRUSTEES.** All members of the Board of Library Trustees shall be bona fide citizens and residents of the Sloan and Salix area. Members shall be over the age of eighteen (18) years.
